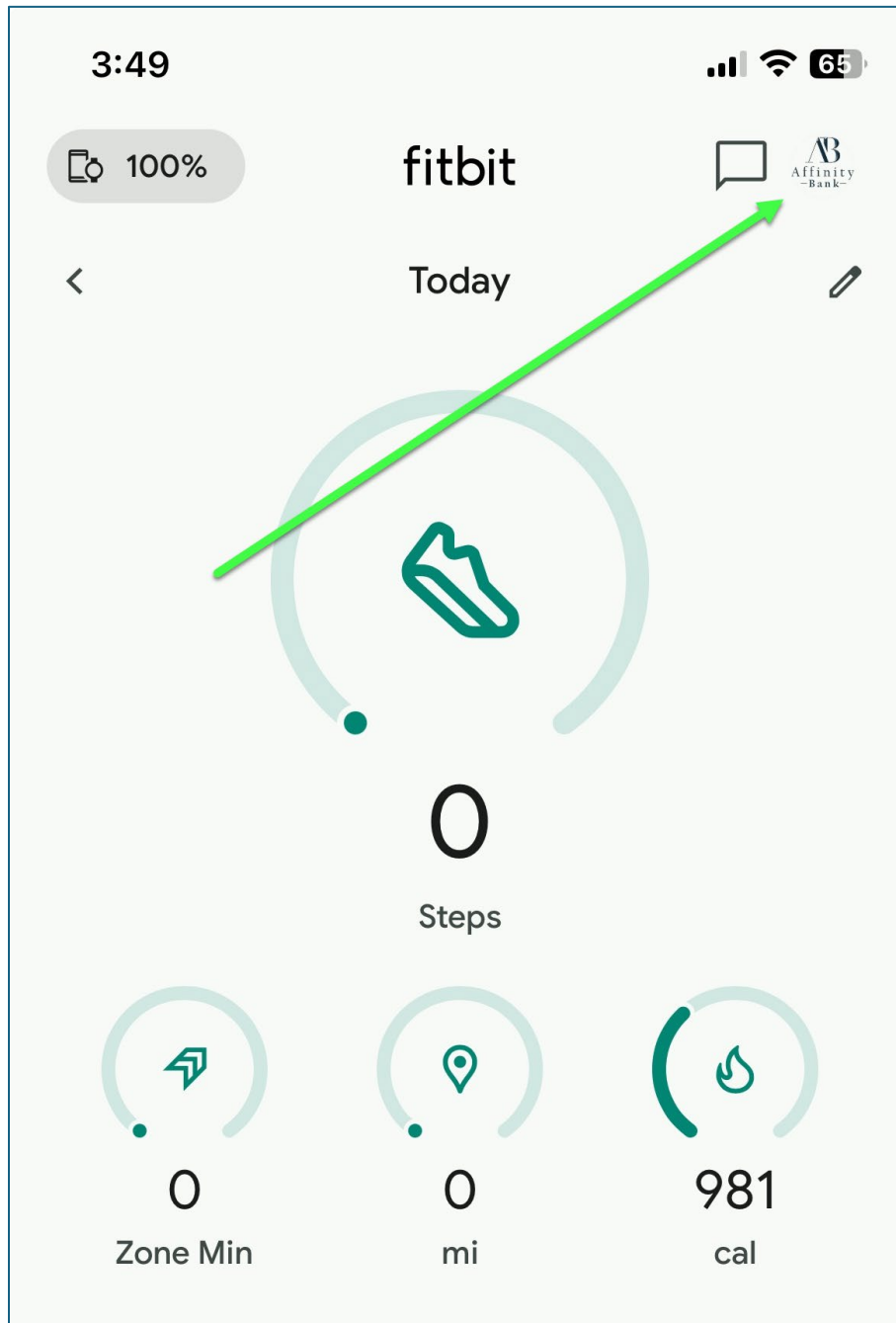


Fitbit – How to know if data is with Fitbit or Google

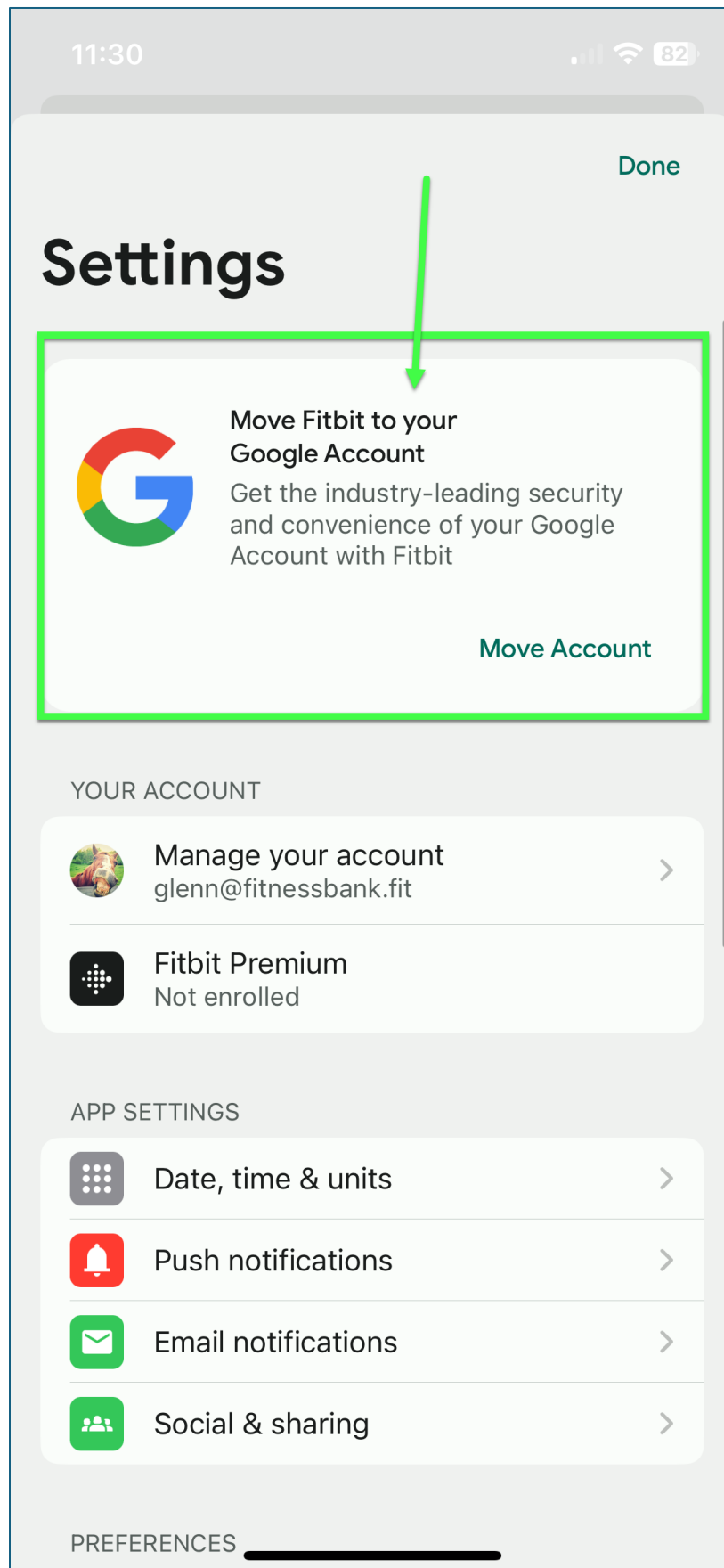
- In 2019, Google Announced they would purchase Fitbit. They said, by sometime in 2025, all Fitbit accounts need to be converted to Google accounts. The migrations will change where data is stored and how users access Fitbit.
- When syncing your Fitbit device to FitnessBank, you will need to enter the credentials that are attached to your Fitbit data (then allow access when prompted).

Steps to determine if your Fitbit data has been migrated and is accessed via Google

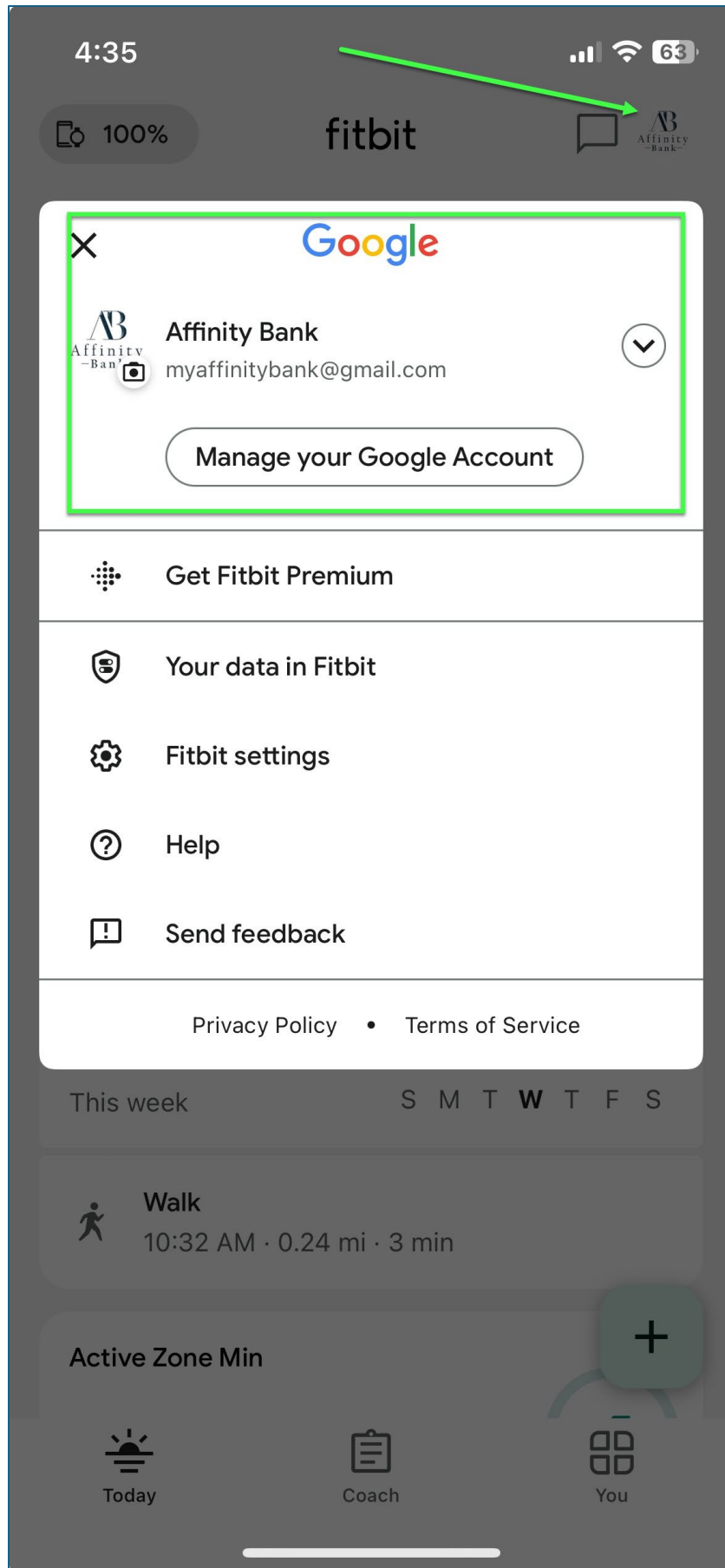
1. Go to Settings in Fitbit



2. If you see the below, *Move Fitbit to your Google Account* – you have **not** converted to Google.



3. If you see an option to *Manage your Google Account*, (see below), you have migrated to Google



4. When syncing to our Step Tracker app, *Sign In* with credentials that corresponded with your Fitbit data.
